Not Just Surface Deep:

How Mould Affects Your Health and Home

Mould isn't always visible – but the effects can be serious. Some types spread quickly, others are linked to allergic reactions or long-term health conditions. While there are many species, these four are the most commonly found in Australian homes. Knowing what you're dealing with is an important step in protecting your home and your health.



Cladosporium

What it is:

A black or green mould commonly found on wood, painted surfaces, and fabrics.

Health risks:

Can trigger asthma, skin irritation, and respiratory allergies.

Property risks:

Often indicates chronic damp; can stain and degrade soft furnishings and painted walls.



Aspergillus

What it is:

A widespread mould that thrives in dust, insulation, and damp areas.

Health risks:

Can cause respiratory infections, particularly in people with existing lung conditions or weakened immune systems.

Property risks:

Often indicates chronic damp; can stain and degrade soft furnishings and painted walls.



Penicillium

What it is:

A blue or green mould that appears on water-damaged surfaces like wallpaper and insulation.

Health risks:

Known to produce allergens; may aggravate respiratory conditions and cause sinus infections.

Property risks:

Fast-spreading; contributes to the decay of timber, plaster, and other porous materials. Degrade soft furnishings and painted walls.



Stachybotrys (Black Mould)

What it is:

A toxic mould often found in areas with persistent moisture or hidden leaks.

Health risks:

Produces mycotoxins linked to fatigue, headaches, and potential neurological effects with prolonged exposure.

Property risks:

Signals long-term water damage; can compromise structural materials and often requires deep remediation.
